GETTING TO THE FESTIVAL BY "HOOK OR BY CROOKE" SHOULD THE ASH FALL

Should the volcano in Iceland cause disruption to air travel there are numerous ferry crossings, which will get you to Ireland by Hook or by Crooke, and get you home again. UK - NORWAY

Although the last ferry between the UK & Norway (DFDS Newcastle to Bergen) was withdrawn in September 2008, it is possible to travel from London to Norway by train, using a lunchtime Eurostar to Brussels, a connecting high-speed train to Cologne, the excellent City Night Line sleeper overnight to Copenhagen and connecting trains to Oslo arriving in the evening the day after leaving London. Or spend the day in Copenhagen then sail overnight by cruise ferry to Oslo. Departures are daily.
